The candidates are advised to read the Information broacher (2023-24), before filling the application form and ensure that no column is left blank. In the event of rejection of the application form, no correspondence will be sent. The status may be known from the Institute website on publishing the merit list.

# A. ADMISSION THROUGH CENTAC (All UG Degree and Diploma seats- Including Self-supporting seats)

Mother Theresa Post Graduate and Research Institute of Health Sciences (MTPG&RIHS) is offering Five U.G.degree courses *i.e.* B.Sc. (Nursing), B.P.T., B.Sc. (MLT), B.Sc. (MRIT)& B.Pharm., four Diploma courses *i.e.* Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery (DGNM), Diploma in Cardiac Care Technology (DCCT), Diploma in Dialysis Technology (DDT), Diploma in Medical Lab Technology (DMLT) and a Certificate Course in Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery (ANM), for the Academic Year 2023-24.

Candidates willing to take admission in this Institute for the above Under Graduate Degree and Diploma courses (except DGNM for ANM qualified candidate) should apply online at CENTAC website (https://www.centacpuducherry.in.). CENTAC is the Centralized Admission Committee constituted by the Government of Puducherry for admission to various professional courses in the U.T. of Puducherry. After obtaining the Provisional Allotment Order from CENTAC the candidate should report at MTPG&RIHS for admission on or before the date specified in the allotment order.

Selection of candidates is based on the marks obtained in the prescribed qualifying examinations. The usual reservation policy as prescribed by the Government of Puducherry will be followed in the allocation of seats.

In case of delay in the declaration of results or issue of original mark certificate of the qualifying examination by any University/Board, the candidates shall not wait but submit the application along with other enclosures, on or before the last date mentioned respectively. In-service candidates must submit their application form along with "No Objection Certificate" from their Appointing Authority to the Office of the Dean before the last date mentioned.

The certificates submitted by the candidates along with the filled-in application should be only in the formats provided in Information Brochure or the format issued by the respective authorities.

#### C. NRI / NRI SPONSORED CANDIDATES

#### The guidelines for NRI / NRI Sponsored admission are as follows

An NRI student is one who has NRI status. Students who have studied their qualifying examination equivalent to 10+2 of India, from schools or colleges abroad (outside India) will also be considered as NRI student.

Candidates should fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria to seek admission under Non Resident Indians (NRI) Category. The seats under NRI quota should be utilized by the children or wards of Bonafide NRI's only. It may be noted that the admission procedure, application form and fees are different from the domestic students.

#### **NRI Category**

As per the GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD, dated 06-08-2014 "An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father/Mother/Brother/Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/Husband /Wife/Brother and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother or guardian (declared as the guardian of the candidate by the court as per provisions in *The Guardian and Wards Act, 1890*") who is working abroad, will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats. Further, the Candidate should be of Indian origin settled in Foreign (OR) Candidate born in a foreign country and whose parents are of Indian citizen deputed abroad by Public Sector Undertaking (OR) Child of the Official of the Central/State Government on deputation abroad shall fall under the NRI category. This is subject to further orders, if any, from Government, regarding the matter.

The candidate himself/herself should produce the proof for NRI or child of NRI with current year NRI certificate issued from the Indian embassy of concerned country along with valid passport and visa copies.

#### **NRI Sponsored Category**

Undertaking should be obtained from the sponsor, who should be an NRI and should sponsor for the relative only, throughout the course. The NRI sponsor should produce valid evidence (Passport & Employment Certificate).

- 1. The eligibility criteria for these students are similar to that of the general category students of the respective courses.
- 2. The admissions made are provisional and subject to approval by the Pondicherry University.
- 3. Admitted candidate shall make their own arrangement for their accommodation / residence during the period of study in this Institute.

#### **Process of Application and Admission**

To apply under this category the candidates will have to download the application form from the CENTAC website <a href="https://www.centacpuducherry.in.">https://www.centacpuducherry.in.</a>duly fill the same and submit along with the following documents:

- 1. Marks card / Transcript of the qualifying examination (English Translated).
- 2. Numerical grade (equivalence) certificate of the qualifying examination.
- 3. Birth certificate or Proof of certificate for date of birth.
- 4. Conduct Certificate from the school last studied.
- 5. Copy of passport and VISA to enter the Country (Student/Parent/Sponsor-VISA/PR/OCI)-wherever/whichever applicable.
- 6. Proof of NRI status of Student / Sponsor.

- 7. Certificate showing the proof for blood relationship of the sponsor for NRI Sponsored candidate.
- 8. Recent passport size colour photograph (2 Nos.).
- 9. Sponsor's postcard size colour photograph(1No.).
- 10. Selected candidates have to sign an agreement bond.

#### 5. COURSE WISE SELECTION PROCEDURE

#### I. Selection procedure for P.G., U.G., Lateral Entry and Diploma courses

#### A. POST GRADUATE DEGREECOURSES

#### (i) M.Sc. (Nursing)

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the merit marks, giving 50% weightage to the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination and 50% weightage to the Mother Theresa Institute Entrance Test [MTIET (PG)]–2023 entrance examination marks. The entrance examination will be conducted by Mother Theresa Post Graduate & Research Institute of Health Sciences (MTPG&RIHS), Gorimedu, Puducherry.

#### (ii) M. Pharm.

The Selection of candidates shall be based on a valid GPAT (Graduate Pharmacist Aptitude Test) percentile/score. In case of a tie in the GPAT score, the aggregate marks of the qualifying examination will be the criteria for ranking. The GPAT candidates need not appear for the MTIET (PG)-2023 entrance examination. The entrance examination will be conducted by Mother Theresa Post Graduate & Research Institute of Health Sciences (MTPG&RIHS), Gorimedu, Puducherry.

When GPAT qualified candidates are not available, admission will be given to non-GPAT candidates of respective category on merit. The selection of Non-GPAT candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the merit marks, giving 50% weightage to the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination and 50% weightage to the MTIET (PG)–2023 entrance examination marks.

In case of grade points / CGPA, the conversion to percentage of marks has to be furnished from the concerned University only. If not, Pondicherry University CGPA conversion table will be used for converting the grade points/CGPA to percentage marks. The speciality selection will be by the choice of the candidates as per merit list. For GPAT Qualified Candidates GPAT scholarship is not guaranteed by the Institution.

#### (iii) M.P.T.

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the merit marks, giving 50% weightage to the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination and 50% weightage to the MTIET (PG)–2023 entrance examination marks. The entrance examination will be conducted by Mother Theresa Post Graduate & Research Institute of Health Sciences (MTPG&RIHS), Gorimedu, Puducherry.

#### **B. UNDER GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES**

- (i) B.Sc. (Nursing) / B.P.T. / B.Sc. (MRIT) admission is based on the marks secured by the candidates in the prescribed subjects in the qualifying examination (*i.e.* Biology/Botany & Zoology, Physics and Chemistry) and normalizing them by the prescribed procedure.
- (ii) B.Sc. (MLT) admission is based on the marks secured by the candidates in the prescribed subjects in the qualifying examination (*i.e.* Biology/Botany & Zoology, Physics and Chemistry) or Physics, Foundation Science and Medical Laboratory Assistance course and normalizing them by the prescribed procedure.
- (iii) B.Pharm. admission is based on the marks secured by the candidates in the prescribed subjects in the qualifying examination (*i.e.*Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following optional subjects: Biology/Botany & Zoology/Mathematics). For all Biology-based Degree courses, *i.e.*B.Sc. (Nursing)/B.P.T./B.Sc. (MLT)/B.Sc. (MRIT) admission is based on the marks secured by the candidates in the prescribed subjects in the qualifying examination (*i.e.*Biology/ Botany & Zoology, Physics and Chemistry) and normalizing them by the prescribed procedure.

#### C. LATERAL ENTRY DEGREE COURSES

#### (i) P.B.B.Sc. (Nursing)

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the merit marks, *i.e.*the aggregate marks (3 Years marks only) obtained in the qualifying examination (D.G.N.M.).

#### (ii) B. Pharm. (Lateral Entry)

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination (D.Pharm.). Diploma approved by BOME/Pondicherry University

#### (iii) B.Sc. (M.L.T.) Lateral Entry

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination (D.M.L.T.). Diploma approved by BOME/Pondicherry University.

#### (iv) B.Sc. (M.R.I.T.) Lateral Entry

The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination (D.C.R.A. Diploma approved by BOME Puducherry).

#### D. DIPLOMA COURSES

- i) D.G.N.M. (After +2), A.N.M., D.C.E.C., D.D.T. and D.M.L.T.: The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination (H.S.C.).
- ii) D.G.N.M. (After A.N.M.): The selection of candidates will be based on the merit list drawn from the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination (A.N.M.).

#### II. RANKING OF CANDIDATES:

Selection of Candidates for admission to the courses will be based on the Merit list prepared by the Institute, based on the percentage of total marks (merit marks) obtained in the respective Qualifying Examinations. Ranking of the candidates will be done based on the 'merit marks' (rounded-off to three decimal places) arrived at, to a base of 100.

#### III. PROCEDURE FOR "TIE BREAK" IN THE MERIT MARKS:

When more than one candidate have got the same marks in the common merit list, the inter-se merit "among such candidates, for each course will be determined in the order of priority" as below:

#### Order of priority for breaking the tie in the marks:

- i) Percentage of actual marks in Biology/Botany &Zoology
- ii) Percentage of actual marks in Physics
- iii) Percentage of actual marks in Chemistry
- iv) Date of Birth (Earlier born)
- v) Random number assigned
- vi) Final year total marks (for P.G. & Lateral Entry Courses)

#### IV. DISPLAY OF MERIT LIST

The common merit list for the courses will be displayed in the Institute Website<a href="http://mtihs.py.gov.in">http://mtihs.py.gov.in</a> and also on the notice board of the Institute's main campus at Puducherry. No separate announcement will be made in the newspaper or communication sent to the candidates separately by post.

#### V. COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION:

The Counselling and Allotment of seats for the Courses will be conducted only at the Puducherry Main campus of the Mother Theresa Post-Graduate & Research Institute of Health Sciences, Indira Nagar, Gorimedu, Puducherry–605006.

Candidates shall be called for counselling as per their merit through Counselling Call Letters. No change of date or time of counselling is permitted on any circumstances. The Institute shall not be responsible for any postal delay. Counselling will not be done in the absence of the candidate. Candidates who do not attend the counselling on the specified date and time will have to forego the claim of admission.

The date and time for the counselling (Schedule) will be published in the institute website <a href="http://mtihs.py.gov.in">http://mtihs.py.gov.in</a>, and individual call letters will be sent to the candidates.

#### **VI. VERIFICATION OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES:**

Candidates called for counselling shall be required to submit all the certificates in original for verification at the time of counselling. Candidates who fail to produce the required certificate in original shall not be considered. However, if a candidate has deposited the original Certificates to an Institution where he/she has already been admitted, a letter/bonafide certificate to that effect issued by the Head of the Institution should be produced only. In such cases the self-attested copies of certificates will be considered for verification, subject to production of all original certificates including Transfer Certificate within the time specified by the Admission Committee.

#### VII. SUBMISSION OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES:

The original certificates submitted by the candidate during admission shall be returned only after completion of the Course. On discontinuation of the Course, the original Certificates will be returned as per the regulations of the Institute. Hence, the candidates are advised to take enough number of photocopies of the Certificates before submitting the originals for verification during counselling.

#### 7. DETAILS OF RESERVATION AND SPECIAL ALLOCATION

#### A. NATIONALITY

A candidate seeking admission at MTPG&RIHS should be an Indian National. However, French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the Treaty of Cession shall be treated on par with Indian Nationals, for the purpose of admission to all the courses.

#### B. DOMICILE CRITERIA FOR U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY

A candidate claiming the UT of Puducherry seats shall submit the respective certificate issued by the competent authority of Govt. of Puducherry.

#### C. VERTICAL AND HORIZONTAL RESERVATIONS

Reservations (Vertical & Horizontal) to different category of candidates for admission to the courses for which selection is done by MTPG & RIHS, Puducherry, are given below. Further SC/ST/BT/EBC/MBC/BCM/OBC candidates are also eligible for selection under Open competition/General category in addition to the reservations made to them.

Seats reserved/allocated under these categories will become operational, only if the minimum number of seats earmarked for each of these categories are not filled up under normal process of selection in any category.

# i) Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Backward Classes (MBC), Extreme Backward Classes (EBC), Backward Classes Muslims (BCM) and Backward Tribes (BT)Candidates:

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose the recent EBC/BCM/BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

#### ii) Scheduled Caste (SC) Candidates

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as scheduled caste under "the CONSTITUTION (PONDICHERRY) SCHEDULED CASTES ORDER 1964" dated 05-03-1964, read with "the constitution (scheduled caste) orders (second amendment) Act 2002 (Central Act 61 of 2002) and should enclose the required recent certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

#### iii) Scheduled Tribe (ST) Candidates

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Tribe under "THE CONSTITUTION (PUDUCHERRY) SCHEDULED TRIBES ORDER. 2016" dated 22-12-2016 and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

#### iv) Freedom Fighter Category (FF)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should be Children/Grand Children of Freedom Fighters and they should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Officer-in-charge, Freedom Fighters' Cell, Government of Puducherry. Link birth certificate of the parent must be produced along with the FF certificate, in case of grandchildren.

#### v) Person with disabilities (PwD)

The Candidates seeking admission under this category should produce a full size photograph exhibiting the deformity.

**a)** Eligibility Criteria for Person with Disabilities (for B.P.T., B.Sc. (MLT), B.Sc. (MRIT), B.Pharm. Courses).

For eligibility under the Person with Disability Quota, locomotor disorder or lower limbs should be between 40% to 70%.

- b) Eligibility under Person with Disabilities for B.Sc. (Nursing) Course.
  - i. Person with locomotor disorder of lower limbs between 40% to 50% only are eligible for nursing courses.
  - ii. Colour Blind candidates should may be considered for admission to Nursing Courses subject to the condition that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates as per the norms prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council.
  - The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two should be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present himself/herself before the Medical Board. The last valid Disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than <a href="https://example.com/THREE\_MONTHS">THREE MONTHS</a> old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates.

**Note:** Candidate with any other DISABILITY other than the locomotor disability of the lower limb will not be considered for the admission into courses. Such application will be summarily rejected without any intimation to the candidates. The decision of the Dean of MTPG&RIHS, Puducherry, in this regard will be final.

#### vi) Ex-Servicemen Category (Ex-SM)

Ex-Servicemen/Widows of Ex- Servicemen/ Wards of Ex-Servicemen who are registered in the Department of Sainik Welfare, Government of Puducherry, come under this category. Candidates claiming admission under this category should enclose necessary certificate issued by the Director/Competent Authority, Department of Sainik Welfare, Puducherry.

#### vii) Meritorious sports person category (MSP):

Candidates claiming admission under this category should have participated in State/National/International level sports and games and to that effect should enclose the necessary certificates, countersigned by the Competent Authority of Directorate of School Education, Govt. of Puducherry.

#### 10.CENTRALLIBRARYANDINFORMATIONCENTRE

- The Central Library and Information Centre functions in a centrally airconditioned hall of about 2500Sq.ft with 100 seating capacity.
- The Library functions from 9.00AM to 5.00PM from Monday to Friday without lunchbreak and 9.00AM to 1.00PM on Saturday.
- The Library has an extensive and updated collection of around 17557 books and subscribes to National and International journals
- The library also subscribes to leading magazines and dailies.
- For better use of the Library, members can have help of the staff.

#### (a) RULESAND REGULATIONS

- Admission to the Library is restricted to the Members and others with special permission from the Dean/Librarian
- Strict silence should be maintained inside the library. The library is for individual study and therefore group discussions or group study is not permitted.
- The users should show their barcoded identity card at the scanner kept at the entrance of the library both while entering and leaving the library.
- The degree students are issued with 3 library cards 1 card for diploma students.
- The tickets/booklets are non-transferable and the loss should be immediately reported to the Librarian. A fee of₹100 will be charged for issuing a duplicate ticket.
- Books can be borrowed against tickets/booklets issued to the borrowers
- Bound volumes and loose issues of periodicals, reference books, CD-ROMs can not be borrowed on loan.
- Books are issued for a period of 28 days. Books should be returned on or before the due date. Overdue books will attract₹1 per day for first seven days and₹2 per day thereafter.
- Before leaving the counter the members should ensure as to whether the books lent to them are in good condition and if not ,it should be reported immediately. Otherwise He/She shall be held responsible for any damage found when the book is returned.
- Loss of books on loan should be reported to the Librarian immediately.
  Members are liable to replace such books with a new book (preferably the
  same edition or the current edition) or pay three times cost of the book. If one
  volume of a set book is lost, the whole set should to be replaced. The members
  are liable to pay the over due charges as admissible, in addition to the cost of
  the book.
- The Postgraduate/Ph.D.student should submit the softcopy of His/Her Theses in a CD.

 Books should be handled with care. Marking on books will be viewed seriously and may attract cancellation of membership privileges.

#### (b) SPECIALFEATURES

- Open Access System is being followed. The members have direct access the books of their interest. The readers are requested not to replace the books after reading. Such books may be left on the nearest table and the same will be shelved by the Library Staff.
- Photocopying of library books and journals shall be made within the ambit of copy right rules at nominal rate.
- Internet browsing facility is available free of cost to the Members.
- The users utilizing the On-line Journals and Internet Browsing facilities should register in the system/software kept for that purpose before & after using the facility.
- To provide better reading ambience, library is equipped with CCTV And Cell phone signal jammer.
- Library is automated with SOUL(Software for University Libraries) software
- This Library is a member of NLISTconsortium- Access to 3000+ e-journals and 75000+ e-books
- Question bank consisting of previous year question papers is also available
- Infringement of the above will lead to cancellation of membership, admission and borrowing books from the library is liable to forfeiture.

#### 11.HOSTEL FACILITIES

#### 12ATTENDANCEREQUIREMENT

The Institute working hours is from 9.00a.m.to 4.00p.m. with lunch break from 1.00 to 2.00p.m. During the clinical posting the students are required to report at 7.30a.m. The night duty schedules are from 8.00p.m.to 8.00a.m. All students should attend theory classes regularly and obtain minimum attendance prescribed by the Pondicherry University, Indian Nursing Council, Pharmacy Council of India and Board of Medical Education, Puducherry. The students are required to ensure 100% attendance in their clinical training.
